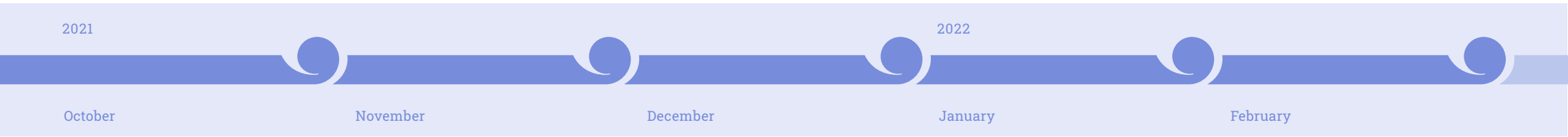


The health reform journey – indicative key dates

- Health Reform Bill introduced to the House
- Select committee for Health Reform Bill commences
- Induction for interim Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority Boards
- Expert Advisory Panels to support the interim New Zealand Health Plan appointed

- Pōwhiri for interim Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority
- Sector engagement on interim New Zealand Health Plan begins
- Interim Public Health Agency established
- Locality prototype sites are selected

- Draft Health Government Policy Statement developed
- Chief Executives for interim Health New Zealand and Māori Health Authority announced

- Initial locality prototypes established

- Sector engagement on the Health Charter begins
